


Present at the meeting were Directors Otos, Coffey, Cook, DeLeon, and Ragusa. A quorum was present. Also in attendance was Superintendent Bruner. Notes by C. Ledin. Some staff and guests included B. Nutting, S. Gilbert, C. Johnson, T. Theisen, P. Popovich, B. Ho, and D. Reeves.

Brian Ho, TCF Architects, presented information on design for the Mount Vernon High School projects. Several options were shared with the board. Director Ragusa shared her preference for Option 1. Superintendent Bruner requested a security person review the proposed plans for student safety.

Dave Reeves, Lydig Construction, reviewed work to date, which is week 27 of construction. The pace is moving very quickly. A Lydig employee was injured during a reportable safety incident that was caused by high winds. There was no fault by the employee. The second round of landscaping bids have been received and will be reviewed. Additional contaminated soils have been discovered that will require additional action.
